The Challenge: Ionia Public School District is comprised of eight school buildings and approximately 3,300 students. With a daily focus on student achievement, staff management, transportation and meals, there's minimal resources to spend improving energy efficiency. Upon learning about the available incentives from Consumers Energy, the district was thrilled to seek funding for its much-needed upgrades, as much of their equipment, including chillers and boilers, was extremely outdated.

The Solution: Consumers Energy performed a walk-through assessment of the district's eight buildings to identify how it could save energy and money. Intrigued with the savings potential, the district agreed to install a variety of energy-saving equipment. Upgrades included LED lighting and controls, boiler replacements and pump and fan motor VFDs.

The Result: Ionia Public School District realized annual energy savings of 883,405 kWh and 2,110 Mcf, lowered their energy bills by more than \$125,000 annually, and received a rebate of \$144,443 from Consumers Energy.
