RETIREE SPOTLIGHT

To help us get to know everyone better, each meeting we will recognize a retiree who is willing to share their story so that we all can get to know each other a little better. This month *Clarence Hill* shared his story.

Clarence Hill also known as Chill, was born in 1941 in St. Ste Marie Michigan. He was almost born in a barn weighing in at 3 ½ pounds. He graduated from Brimley HS in 1961 with a graduating class of 36. He was drafted into the Army at 22 years old. Chill was part of the first All Helicopter Unit in the US. He went to Vietnam in 1965. He was part of a major battle called the Battle of ladrang which later became part of a book and a movie. The book is titled **We were soldiers once and young**. After Vietnam, Chill didn't want to live in the UP so he went to work for the State Hwy and helped build Hw 696. In July Chill started working at Consumers Energy. Chill work in gas and ended up working in Cathodic protection and worked for Roxanne Pesky. He retired in 2001 and in 2003 was diagnosed with ALS. He and his wife, Alice have also lead ALS support groups for 10+years.
